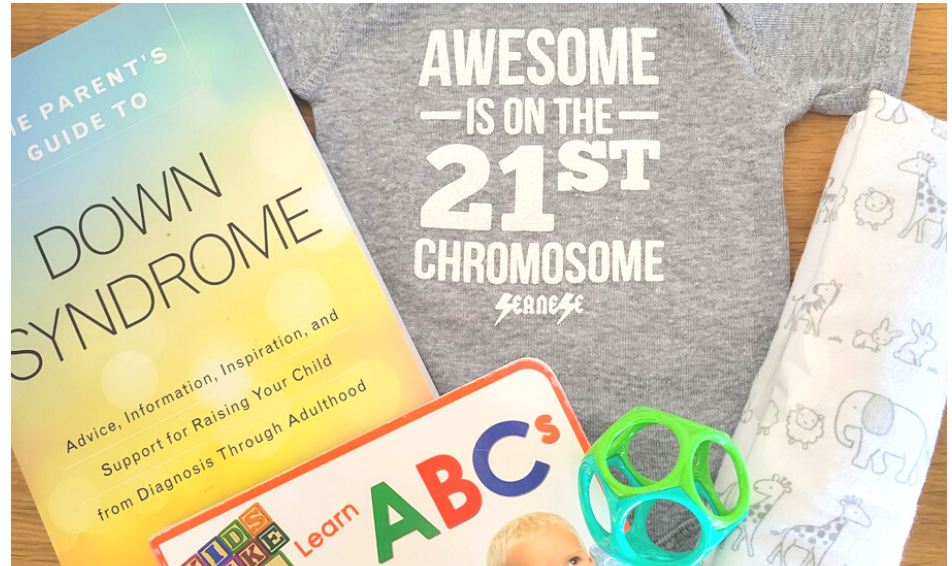

We hope that next year we'll be able to grow the program even more!

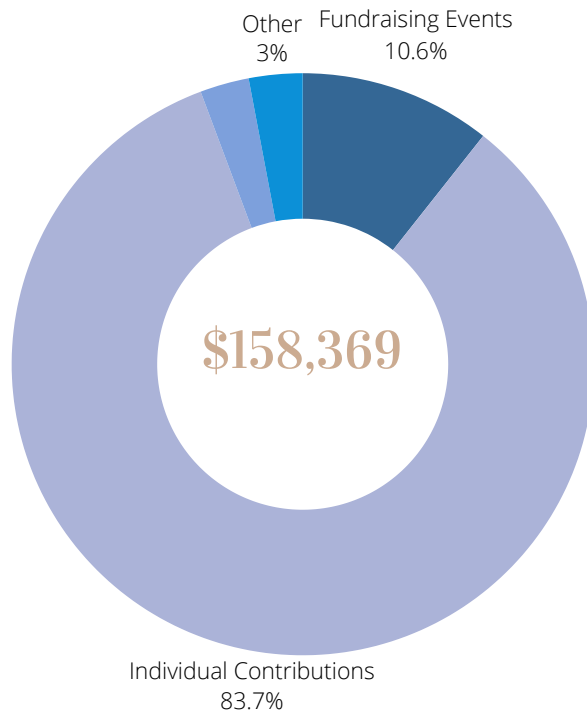


22ND ANNUAL TOLEDO BUDDY WALK

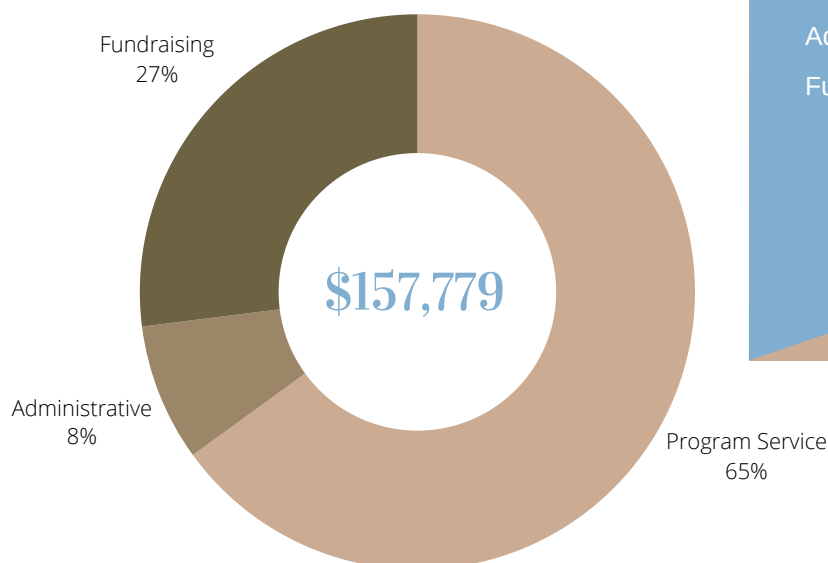


2023 REVENUE
